REGISTRATIONS

- Registrations for the race will be accepted electronically (www.foxter-sport.pl)
- Required information for registration: participant's name and surname, date of birth, club, nationality, city, shirt size, and race category.
- Registrations are open until March 3, 2024
 - On-site at the event, the legal guardian of the child must complete necessary declarations and present a valid identification document - ID card or passport. Adult participants must also present a valid ID card or passport and complete necessary declarations.
 - The participant's decision to register for the race along with paying the entry fee is considered a declaration of the participant's proper health condition allowing them to participate in the race. Only individuals in good health have the right to start. Any symptoms of discomfort, including fever, cough, or shortness of breath, must be reported immediately to the organizer/medical rescuer.

DATA PROTECTION

Personal data of participants in the COMPETITION will be processed for the purpose of conducting the event, determining the winner, and awarding, issuing, receiving, and settling the prize.

Personal data of participants in the COMPETITION will be used in accordance with the conditions specified in the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Protection of Personal Data from 27.04.2016 - GDPR (EU L 119 of 04.05.2016). The joint data administrators are the Organizer and Foxter Group Sp. z o.o. based in Pniewy at ul. Cicha 8, entered into the Entrepreneurs Register under KRS number: 0000756026, for which the registration files are kept by the District Court in Poznań – Nowe Miasto and Wilda in Poznań. Detailed rules for processing personal data are available on the foxter-sport.pl website in the privacy policy section.

The processing of data mentioned in paragraph 1 of this paragraph in connection with participation in the COMPETITION also includes the publication of the participant's name and surname along with the name of the town in which they reside - in any way in which the project will be published or distributed.

The participant has the right to access and correct their personal data.

Providing personal data and giving consent to their processing is voluntary, but not providing them or refusing to consent to their processing makes it impossible to participate in the COMPETITION. By submitting a properly completed and signed registration form to the Organizer, the participant gives consent and allows the use of their personal data for the purpose of sending information about future events, commercial products, as well as for internal administrative and analytical purposes, in accordance with the Act of May 10, 2018, on the protection of personal data, Journal

of Laws 2018, item 1000. The participant has the right to withdraw such consent and may do so at any time by sending correspondence to the Organizer's address. All information about participants obtained by the Joint Administrators and included in the registration form will be electronically stored and in any case will be used in accordance with the Act of May 10, 2018, on the protection of personal data, Journal of Laws 2018, item 1000. The Organizer will not disclose this information to any third parties.

Starter pack

- Each participant must be verified at the competition office by submitting a correctly completed declaration. To verify, an identification document such as an ID card or passport will be required.
- The participant (captain) is responsible for collecting the number and starter pack during the verification at the competition office.
- By signing the statement, the guardian simultaneously accepts the conditions of the regulations.
- Only those individuals who do not show symptoms of discomfort, elevated temperature, cough, or shortness of breath will be allowed to start.
- Each participant is obliged to adhere to all safety rules, fair play rules, and comply with the organizer's decisions.
- Any signs of aggression, unsportsmanlike behavior, or discrimination of others will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- Each participant is responsible for providing themselves with appropriate sports attire.

- Swimming skills are not required during the competition; however, participants should demonstrate physical and mental strength.
- Statements and instructions from the organizer, judge, or volunteer cannot be questioned by race participants.
- In case of disputes, the Organizer has the final say.

The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations. Participants will be informed of any changes.

Rules

Eliminations (Saturday):

Eliminations will consist of 10 Ninja stations

Duration of the station - 1 min.

Break between stations - 30 s.

At each station, the participant must correctly perform given tasks to earn points.

In categories 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, and ELITE, the TOP 8 M and TOP 8 F advance to the semi-finals

In case of the same number of points, both participants receive an advance to the semi-finals.

In categories 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-45, 46+

TOP 6 M and TOP 6 F advance to the semi-finals

In case of the same number of points, both participants receive an advance to the semi-finals.

All elimination rules - RULEBOOK will be published by January 31, 2024.

Semi-finals and Finals (Sunday)

Participants compete on the Ninja Course consisting of a minimum of 6 obstacles.
The course will be for 2 people - the time to complete the course counts - no elimination in a 1 vs 1 duel

All rules for the semi-final and final will be presented during the technical briefing on the day of the competition.

Semi-finals - 2 attempts at the obstacle - 1 attempt at the course

In categories 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, and ELITE

TOP 8 M and TOP 8 F from eliminations

In categories 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-45, 46+

TOP 6 M and TOP 6 F from eliminations

Finals - 1 attempt at the obstacle - 1 attempt at the course
